The non-profit organization Human Riddim Care was founded in 2019, after Ralf Eggenberger had provided direct emergency aid in Greece, in Sindos and Lesbos, in the summer of 2016 to spring 2018, he came back to Switzerland. Since his return he has continued to support people who depend on his help, both financially and with advice and action. At the beginning of June 2019, Ralf Eggenberger and Andrea Vetsch flew to Athens to visit the people Ralf has been looking after for two years. The inhumane circumstances on site and the private financial limits made Ralf and Andrea decide to found a non-profit organization.

Human Riddim Care's current projects include:

- RAD Music International
A musical group consisting of people on the run, which sings for human rights and hope.
- RAD Education
A small school in Camp Moria for children from African families. The school teaches 60 children and young people in French, English, math, sports and games.
- Help with legal fees for refugees
- Help with financing accommodation for families with small children
