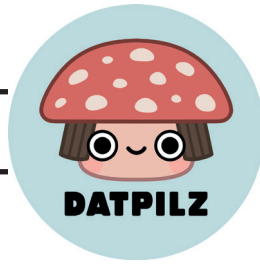

st	stitch
ch	chain
slst	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet

inc	increase

KITTY WITCH

MATERIAL

YARN OF YOUR CHOICE

blue, black, orange,
white

SEWING THREAD

black, yellow, pink

OTHER

crochet hook matching your yarn,
fiberfill, glue, wire

FELT

yellow, pink, black, white

HEAD

use blue yarn

R1: ch 4

**Start with 2nd ch from hook and
crochet in the chains.**

R2: sc 3 = 6sts
(count the 3 sc you just made
plus the 3 chs from R1)

**Work in rounds, so simply continue to
crochet on the other side of the first
beginning chain.**

R3: inc 6 = 12 sts

R4: 6x [sc 1, inc 1] = 18 sts

R5: sc 18

R6: 6x [inc 1, sc 2] = 24 sts

R7: sc 24

R8: 6x [sc 3, inc 1] = 30 sts

R9-13: sc 30

R14: 6x [sc 3, dec 1] = 24 sts

R15: 6x [dec 1, sc 2] = 18 sts

R16: 6x [sc 1, dec 1] = 12 sts

- Stuff the head with fiberfill.

R17: dec 6 = 6 sts

- Fasten off and leave a long tail to
sew the open end together.

BODY

start with orange yarn

R1: work 6 sc in a ring

R2: inc 6 = 12 sts

R3: 6x [sc 1, inc 1] = 18 sts

R4: 6x [sc 2, inc 1] = 24 sts

R5: sc 24

change to black yarn

R6: sc 24

R7: back loops only: sc 24

R8: 6x [sc 2, dec 1] = 18 sts

R9: sc 18

R10: slst 1

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for
sewing.
- Stuff the body with fiberfill and sew
it to the head.

SKIRT

use black yarn

**work in the 24 loops at the body from
round 7; start at the back of the body;
hold the body upside down:**

R1: sc 24

R2: 6x [sc 3, inc 1] = 30 sts

R3: sc 30

R4: 10x [slst 1, 3 sc in 1 st, slst 1]

- Fasten off and leave a long tail.
- Hide the loose yarn tails.

EARS (make 2)

use blue yarn

R1: work 4 sc in a ring

R2: 2x [inc 1, sc 1] = 6 sts

R3: 2x [sc 2, inc 1] = 8 sts

R4: sc 8

R5: 2x [inc 1, sc 3] = 10 sts

R6: slst 1

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for
sewing.
- Flatten the ears and sew them to the
head.

HAT

use black yarn

- R1:** work 4 sc in a ring
R2: 2x [inc 1, sc 1] = 6 sts
R3: 2x [sc 2, inc 1] = 8 sts
R4: 2x [inc 1, sc 3] = 10 sts
R5: 2x [sc 4, inc 1] = 12 sts
R6: sc 12
R7: front loops only:
6x [sc 1, inc 1] = 18 sts
R8: 6x [inc 1, sc 2] = 24 sts
R9: slst 1

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Stuff the hat with fiberfill and sew it to the head.

LEGS (make 2)

start with black yarn

- R1:** work 4 sc in a ring
R2: 2x [inc 1, sc 1] = 6 sts
R3: 2x [sc 2, inc 1] = 8 sts
R4: sc 8

change to orange yarn

- R5-7:** sc 8
R8: slst 1

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Stuff the legs slightly with fiberfill and sew them to the body.

ARMS (make 2)

start with blue yarn

- R1:** work 4 sc in a ring
R2: 2x [inc 1, sc 1] = 6 sts
R3: sc 6

change to black yarn

R4: sc 6
R5: 2x [sc 2, inc 1] = 8 sts
R6-8: sc 8
R9: slst 1

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Put some wire into the arms, stuff them slightly with fiberfill and sew them to the body.

TAIL

use blue yarn

- R1:** ch 15

**Start with 2nd ch from hook and
crochet in the chains.**

- R2:** slst 14

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Use both yarn tails to sew the tail to the body.

FINISH

use felt and yarn

- Cut the eyes and nose from felt and sew or glue them onto the face. (I used yellow, black and white felt for the eyes and pink felt for the nose.)
- Use white yarn to embroider the mouth, whiskers and shoestrings.



- If you want you can glue some stars onto the body, skirt and hat.

BACKPACK

use orange yarn

- R1: work 6 sc in a ring
R2: inc 6 = 12 sts
R3: 6x [sc 1, inc 1] = 18 sts
R4- 5: sc 18
R6: 3x [sc 4, dec 1] = 15 sts
R7: sc 15
R8: 3x [sc 3, dec 1] = 12 sts
R9-12: sc 6;
1 ch and turn work
R13: dec 3

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

- You can just hide the loose yarn tail or use it to sew the flap to the backpack.

STRAPS (make 2)

use orange yarn

Leave a long tail at the beginning for sewing.

R1: ch 12

- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Use the loose yarn tails to sew the straps to the back of the backpack.
- Put the backpack on Kitty's back.
