# VINES

Wine origin : Domaine

#### LOCATION

The vinesare in the regional Burgundy appellation located on the edge of the Chablis vineyard.

## TERROIR

The soil are clay-limestone. The subsoil varies between Portlandian and Kimmeridgian.

## IN THE VINEYARD

Weeding is exclusively mechanical. The summer was dry, the disease pressure was low. The quality of the harvest was exceptional.

#### Varietals : Chardonnay 100% - Surface area of the vineyard : 4 ha - Age of vines: 10 years old

# VINIFICATION & MATURING

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After rigorous settling, fermentation alcoholic are made in thermo-regulate stainless still tanks. The fermentation is quite long, about one or two months. Once these are completed, it is the turn of malolactic fermentation.

#### AGEING

The ageing in stainless steel tanks took a short year on fine lees to give the wine all its roundness and aromatic complexity.

Alcohol content : 13 ABV

# SERVING & TASTING

## TASTING NOTES

BLight gold color, luminous. Nose dominated by almonds, white fruits, lemon, lime blossom honey. Full fruity mouth, stimulating, adorned with a generous substance, a fatty and tender finish, a salivating freshness. Rich, full burgundy.

Ageing potential : 2 to 3 years, 5 years

## SERVING

Service temperature is 12 à 14 °C.

#### FOOD AND WINE PAIRINGS

To consume with white meats, fish in sauces or even with foie gras.

# OUR COMPANY

The Vincent Wengier vineyard is located in the village of Préhy in the heart of the Chablis vineyards. Winemaker for three generations, Sophie and Vincent made the 2018 vintage their first bottling. Respectful of good cultural and environmental practices, the estate operates around 25 ha of vines. Spread over 4 appellations, two from Chablisien: Chablis and Petit Chablis, and two from Burgundy:

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Bourgogne Chardonnay and Bourgogne Aligoté.

The Vincent Wengier vineyard has HVE -high environmental value- certification since 2019 vintage. 2020 is the first year of conversion to vineyard management in organic farming
