

Dear Rotary District Chairs,

Thank you for your terrific support of the NYSF over the past year.

All of us at NYSF greatly appreciated Rotary's ongoing support while we adapted to meet the challenges of COVID-19. We are delighted that the 2021 new look hybrid Year 12 Program went exceptionally well, far exceeding our expectations.

Based on the successful delivery of the hybrid program in January 2021, and after carefully considering risk, we have concluded that a similar hybrid model of delivery to that deployed in 2021 is the most appropriate choice for January 2022.
