Filling the roles of National Representatives working in delegations, the students will have to coordinate their actions beyond their assigned committees and negotiate their standpoints within both the North Atlantic Council, the Military Committee, as well as a scenario-dependent third committee.

As a Team Member in the Registration & Admissions Department, you will be responsible for the design and evaluation of the application process in coordination with other members of the organizational team. During the Conference itself, the activities mainly consist of registering participants and other guests, such as our partners, as well as being their main point of reference.
