They meet twice a month at lunch times, with a Rotary/Rotaract member in attendance

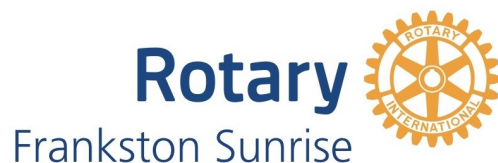
