The sessions for 2025 are now confirmed and forms are attached for you to sign and return as soon as possible, <u>but no later than 15</u> <u>November 2024</u>, along with the payment of £40.00. These costs are heavily subsidised by the Wombwell Cricket Lovers' Society and represent excellent value in comparison with other coaching sessions. From 2025 our Head Coach will be **Hugh Tingle**, a very experienced coach well known in the Barnsley & District Junior Cricket League. All our coaches are ECB Level 2 and higher.

With the change of Head Coach the Society has taken the opportunity to review all the arrangements for coaching and the following changes are being made in time for the classes commencing in January. The changes are as follows:-

- Adoption of the Safe Hands Policy of the England & Wales Cricket Board (ECB) so far as it applies to our situation, including the adoption of a Child Safeguarding Policy. More information about these elements is on the enrolment form's reverse side and on our website.
- Appointment of a Child Safeguarding Officer. We are delighted to announce that Lindsay Pepper who undertakes a Safeguarding Coordination role for the Barnsley & District Junior Cricket League, has agreed to take on this role on behalf of the Society for the duration of the classes. Lindsay will sit on the Society's committee to provide expert advice in the field.
- Closer alignment of the coaching classes with the other activities of the Society. The Society's committee has agreed to extend a Junior membership of the Society to all enrolled participants and to one parent (or guardian) of each participant. I will be writing further to all participants and parents to explain this new development and what it means in more detail once we have a completed enrolment register for the 2025 classes.

Details of the Wombwell Cricket Lovers' Society Coaching Classes for 2025:

- Venue: Indoor Cricket School, Sheffield Hallam University Sports Park, Bawtry Road, Sheffield S9 1AU;
- **Dates:** Tuesday 7 January 2025 to Tuesday 25 February 2025 incl.;
- Time: 6.45 pm to 8.15 pm;
- Dress: Cream or White cricket clothing MUST be worn at all times although tracksuit bottoms are considered to be acceptable if
 worn with a cricket shirt or cricket sweater. Football shirts are not considered acceptable. It is a rule that shoes worn outside
 must be changed before entering the Sports Hall.

Whilst we encourage youngsters to enjoy themselves and have a good time it must be remembered that cricket nets can be a dangerous environment if basic safety rules are not observed. All participants and their parents should be aware of the possible risks that are involved. Everyone is expected to behave in a responsible manner and not spoil the enjoyment of others by being disruptive. Please listen to the coaches at all times. It is their prime intention to develop the skills of all the youngsters in an enjoyable way. Everyone will have the same opportunity and in this way, you will gain maximum benefit and most importantly total enjoyment. There are facilities for spectators to view from the balcony but only official WCLS coaches and young cricketers will be allowed to enter the nets.

Finally, we would like to emphasise that our coaching scheme is all about extending opportunities to aspiring youngsters who wish to play this great game. As such, our course is not aimed at, nor suitable for, players who are already established on the Yorkshire pathways programme.
