- This program focuses on acquiring basic scientific knowledge and practical application skills to solve various problems in water environment science and water treatment engineering.
- This program accepts students from various sciences and engineering fields, not limited to environmental engineering and environmental sciences.
- All lectures necessary for graduation are carried out in English.


- ✓ Appropriate water treatment engineering for Africa and Asia
