Welcome to Ratha Yatra Amsterdam 2024

We are very much delighted to receive you on the annual Ratha Yatra Chariot Parade festival. In this leaflet you'll find all practical information about the parade and festival. In case you have any questions or require assistance, feel free to come to one of the volunteers, who can be found in the book stall.

How to reach?

The start location of the parade is in front of the temple at Lizzy Ansinghstraat 80. Tram 12 stops in front of the street (Tram stop Van Hilligaertstraat), and metro 51 (De Pijp) is 5 minutes walk from the temple building.

Dam Square area can be reached by metro 51 (Rokin) and multiple tram lines. Amsterdam Central Train Station is 10 minutes walk to Dam Square.

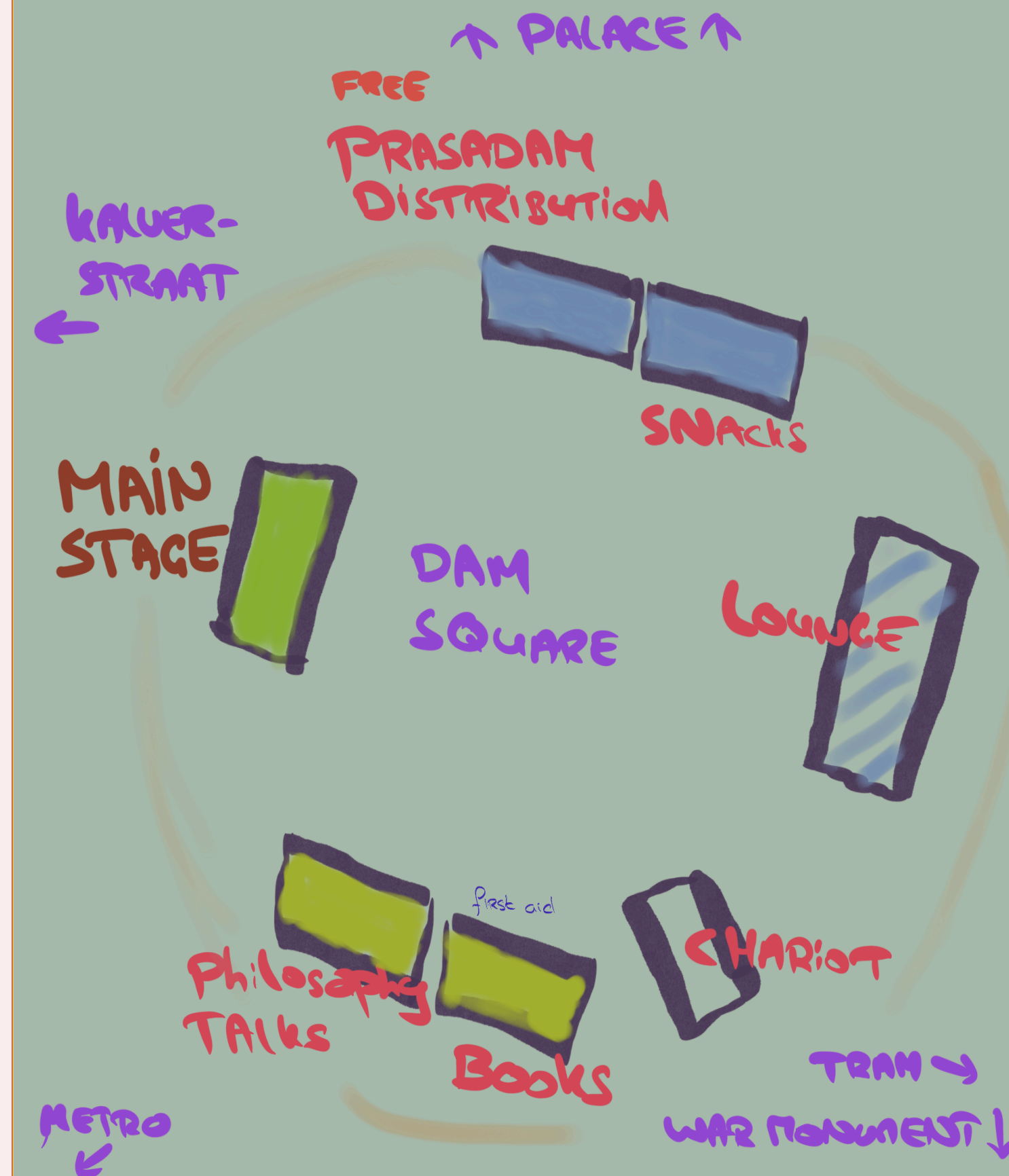
Parking on both locations is difficult and expensive. If you come by car, we advise you to park at P+R Noord or Rai, and take metro 51 to Rokin Station.

Please note it is not allowed to either drive or park on Dam Square. Only vehicles for which special permission has been requested by the organisation, are allowed to do so.
