

Judo training at l'Oumière sports center

FEATURES

- A hall with two contest areas.
- The hall has an area of 457m²,
- A pit installation reduces the risk of injury,
- Spectator seating for 175 of which 5 are accessible for people with disabilities.
- 35m² of changing rooms for athletes;
 - 8 column showers with one accessible to people with disabilities; toilet block,
- 11m² of fully equipped changing rooms and facilities for referees.
- Situation: main building of l'Oumière sports centre.



COMPETITION AND TOP-LEVEL SPORTSPEOPLE

- Elisa Sueur, a contender for the French judo team started her career here and is now training at Bordeaux at the under 70kg level.
- For more than 25 years, the centre has organised Boyardville Judo Tournaments at Category A.
- The Fort Boyard Junior National Tournament has been held here for more than 11 years.

- An athletes' recovery centre to be opened in 2022,
- A secure sports centre with security cameras, available to all,
- Accommodation close to the sports centre,
- A new weights room of 155m², fully equipped and available,
- Two outdoor stadia and a synthetic coated athletics track,
- A multisport hall equipped for basketball and handball,
- A teaching and meeting room,
- Bus parking.
