


On this day in... September 2 :

Event: **44 BC** - Queen Cleopatra VII of Egypt declares her son co-ruler as Ptolemy XV Caesarion. **1666** - Great Fire of London begins at 2am in Pudding Lane, 80% of London is destroyed. **1792** - September Massacres of the French Revolution: In Paris rampaging mobs slaughter 3 Roman Catholic bishops, more than two hundred priests, and prisoners believed to be royalist sympathizers. **1901** - Theodore Roosevelt advises "Speak softly & carry a big stick". **1931** - Bing Crosby makes his solo radio debut. **2018** - Major fire at the National Museum of Brazil in Rio de Janeiro destroys most of its 20 million artifacts.

Births: **1877** - Frederick Soddy, English chemist, Nobel laureate (Contribution for the chemistry of radioactive substances and proved the existence of isotopes of certain radioactive elements). **1936** - Andrew Grove, Hungarian-American pioneer in the semiconductor industry and one of the founders and CEO of Intel, born in Budapest, Hungary. **1955** - Linda Purl, actress (Gloria-Happy Days, Matlock). **1964** - Keanu Reeves, Canadian actor (Bill & Ted's Excellent Adventure, The Matrix).

Deaths: **490 BC** - Pheidippides, Greek hero and inspiration for the modern marathon. **1964** - Alvin York, American World War I soldier who led a famed attack on a German machine gun nest (Medal of Honor). **1996** - Emily Kngwarreye, Aboriginal Australian artist from the Utopia community in the Northern Territory. She is one of the most prominent and successful artists in the history of contemporary Indigenous Australian art. **2005** - Bob Denver, American actor (Gilligan's Island).
