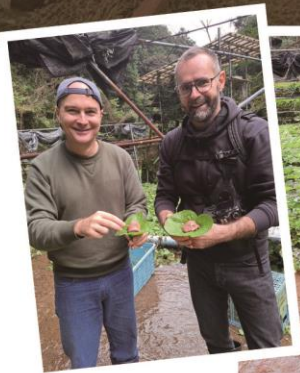
Once there, you can harvest fresh wasabi, grate it on the spot, and taste its unmatched flavor.
