In this project we would like to explore the possibilities of relationships between human beings and AI.




What does it feel like to live, communicate and cooperate with someone who was created by us but is not one of us.


In “Conjunction” art exhibition we use AR technology to present the work we have done. Just take a device from a stand and point its camera on one of the images on the wall to see the art piece.
