Event: 1804 - Napoleon Bonaparte is crowned Emperor of France in Paris. 1845 - Manifest Destiny: US President James K. Polk announces to Congress that the United States should aggressively expand into the West. 1946 - In rain affected 1st Test in Brisbane, Australia compiles 1st innings total 645 on Day 3 v India (Bradman 187, Hassett 128); Australia wins by an innings and 332. 1973 - Davis Cup Men's Tennis, Cleveland: After clinching a famous victory the previous day, Australians Rod Laver and John Newcombe finish a 5-0 rout of the US with wins over Stan Smith and Tom Gorman. 2014 - Stephen Hawking claims that Artificial Intelligence could be a "threat to mankind" and spell the end of the human race.

Births: 1921 - Isabella Karle, American scientist who was instrumental in developing techniques to extract plutonium chloride. 1940 - Constance "Connie" Booth, American writer, actress, comedienne and psychotherapist (Fawlty Towers, Monty Python and the Holy Grail). 1950 - Amin Saikal, Afghan-Australian academic (politics, history, political economy and international relations of the Middle East and Central Asia). 1971 - Rachel McQuillan, Australian tennis player (5 WTA, 21 ITF titles). 1986 - Tal Wilkenfeld, Australian musician (Jeff Beck, Prince).

Deaths: 1814 - Marquis de Sade, French philosopher and writer (Justine), dies at 74. The words sadism and sadist are derived from his name. **1935** - James Henry Breasted, American Egyptologist and anthropologist. **1953** - Reginald "Snowy" Baker, Australian boxer (Olympic silver middleweight 1908), rugby union halfback (2 caps) and actor (The Sword of Valor). **1965** - Maharajkumar of Vizianagram "Vizzy", Indian cricket batsman, captain, administrator, broadcaster and politician (3 Tests). **1986** - Desi Arnaz, Cuban-American actor (Ricky Ricardo-I Love Lucy).
