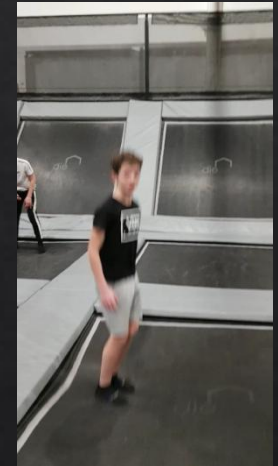
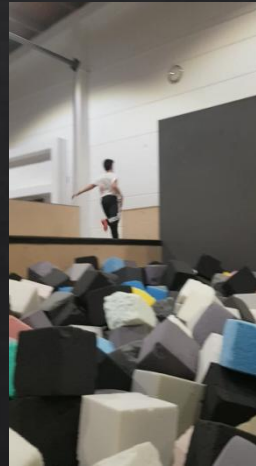


First day – 20th January

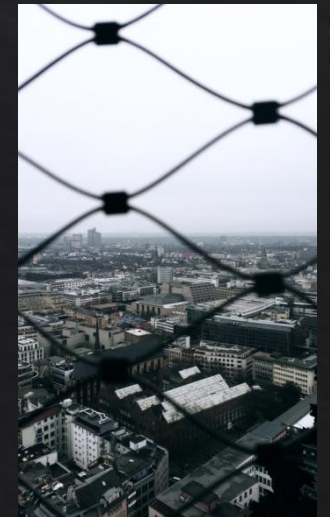
Later we had a walk and had lunch, and then they took us to an escape room, which was quite interesting and fun. Then, we had free time and did some shopping and explored the streets.

1 hour later, we entered in the cathedral and we went on a tour, it was a little interesting but also boring.

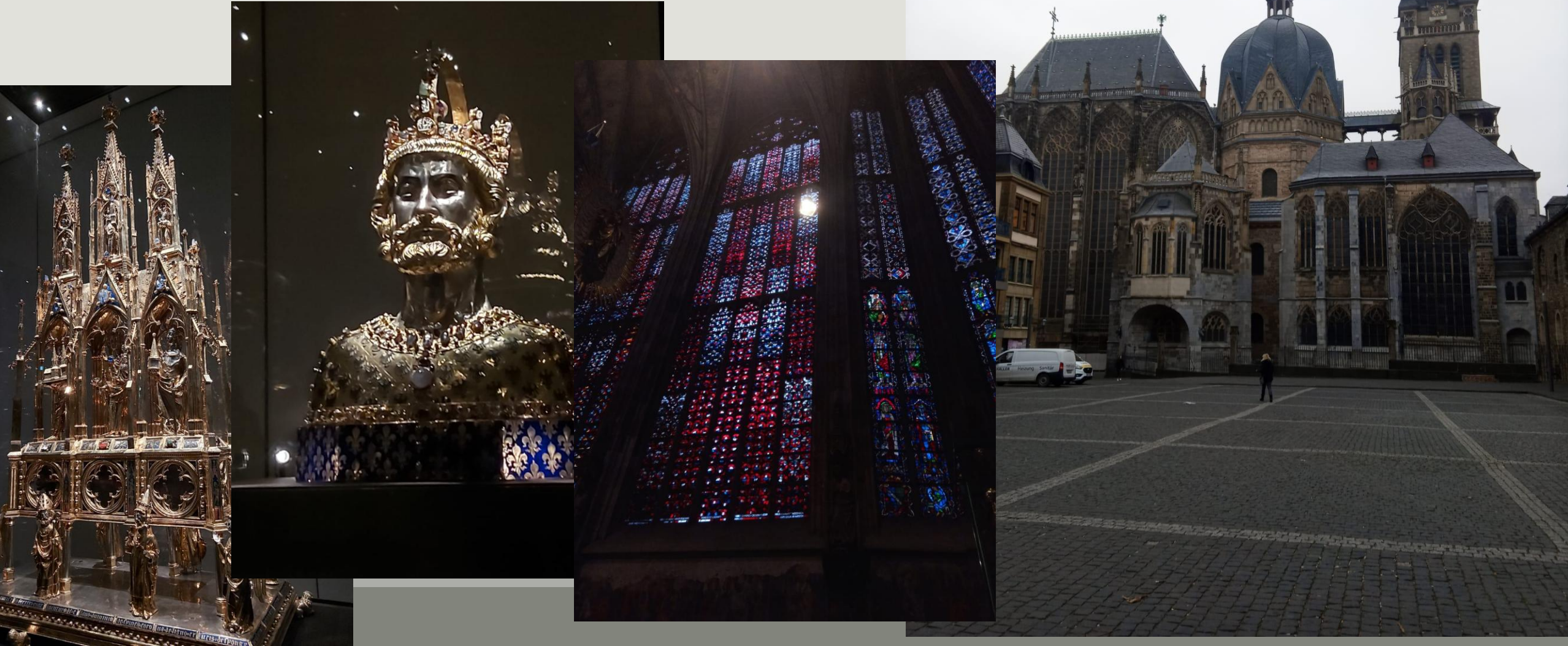

I had a great time and I would repeat this trip millions of times.

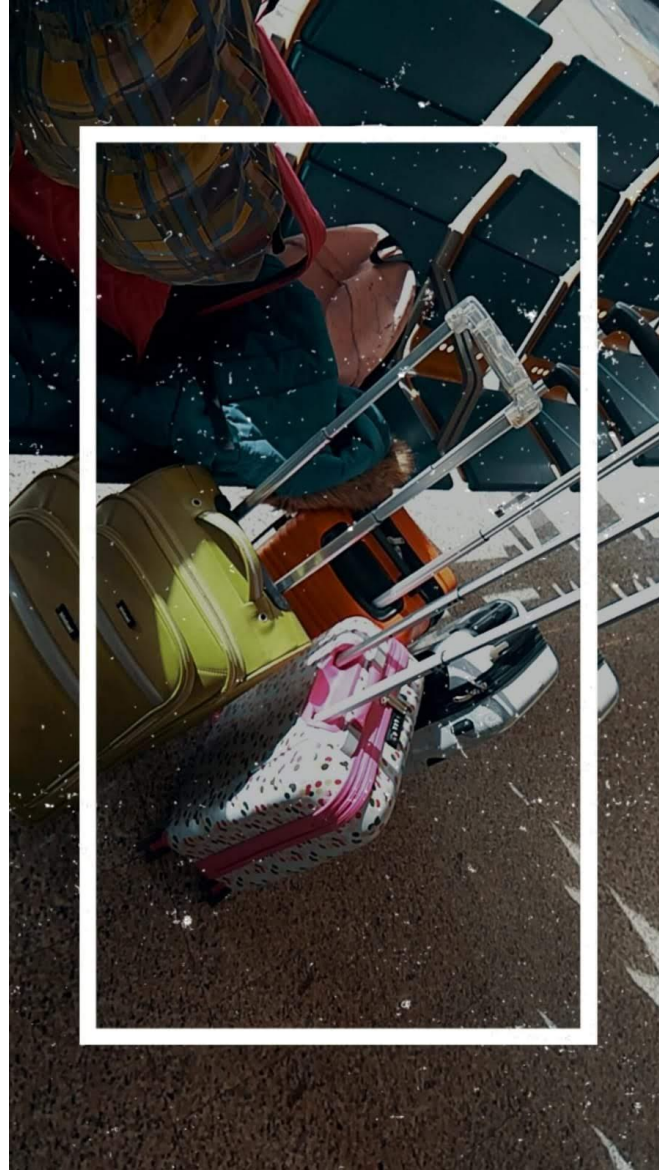

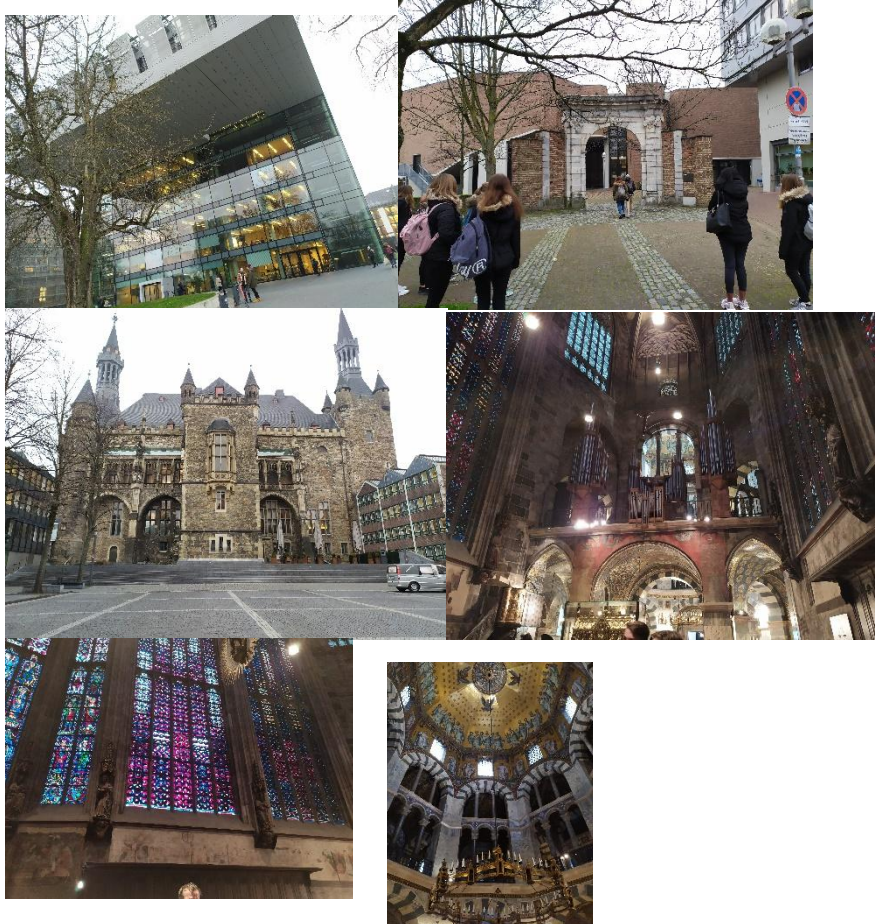


Tuesday 21 of January of 2020

Wednesday 22 of January of 2020. Aachen

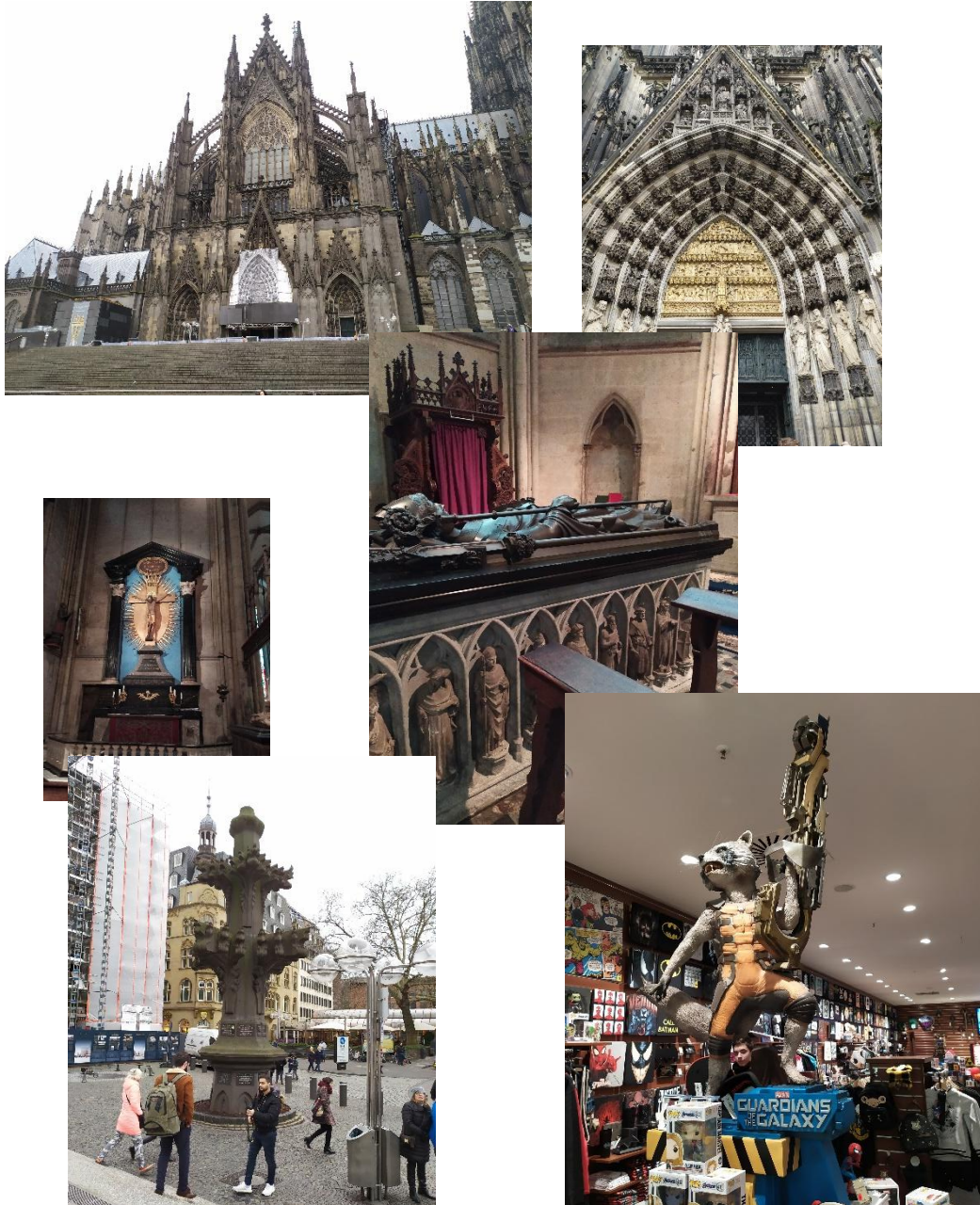

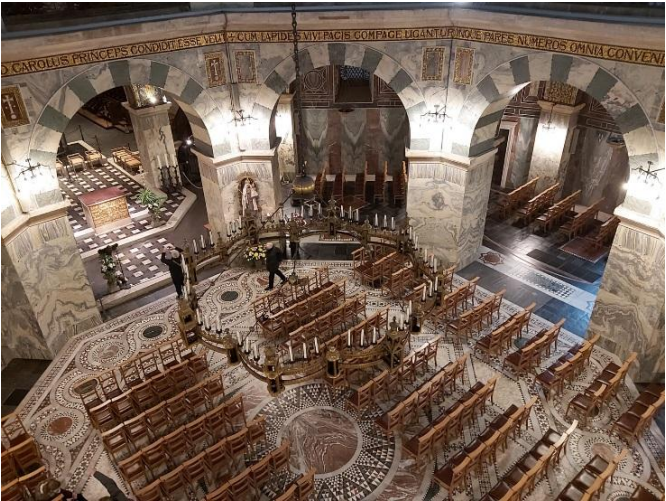
Tuesday:

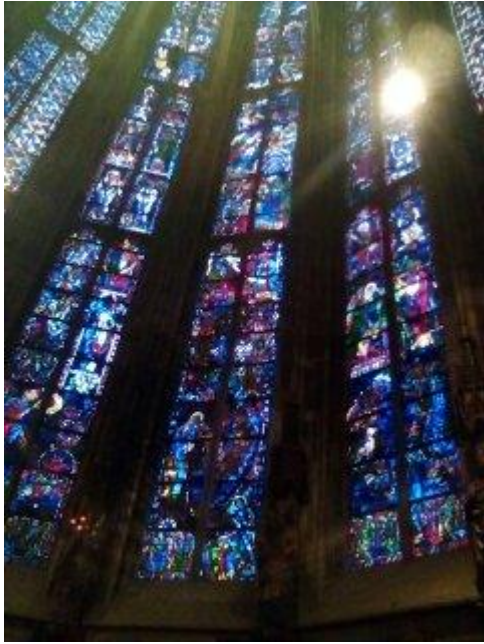
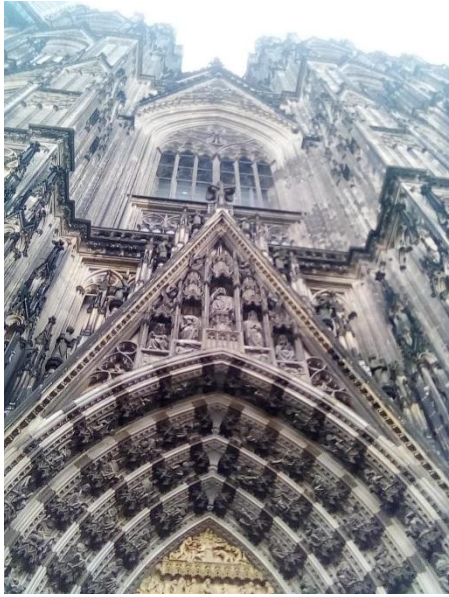
Wednesday:

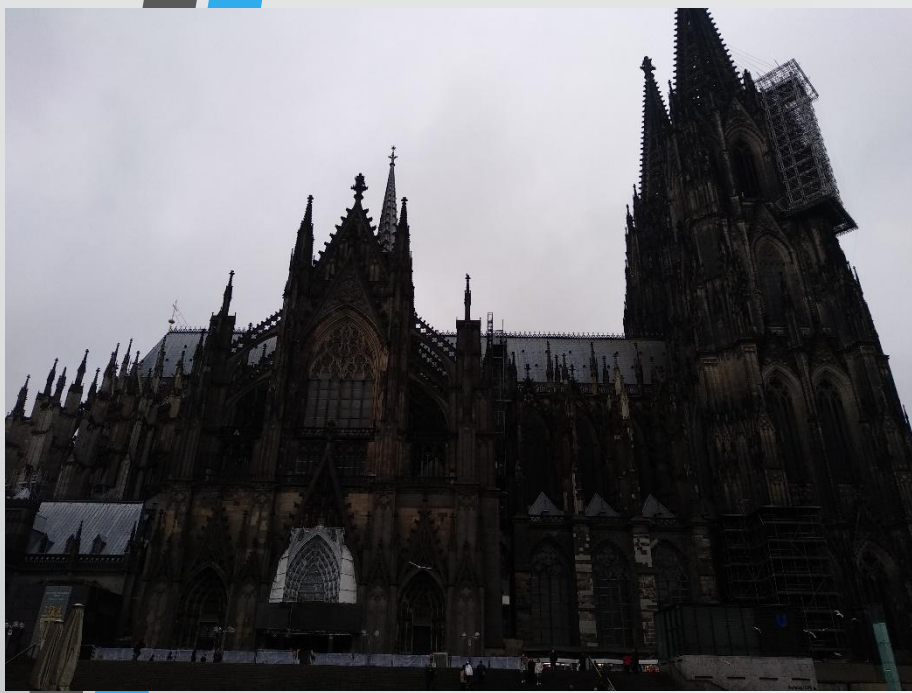
Second day

Third day

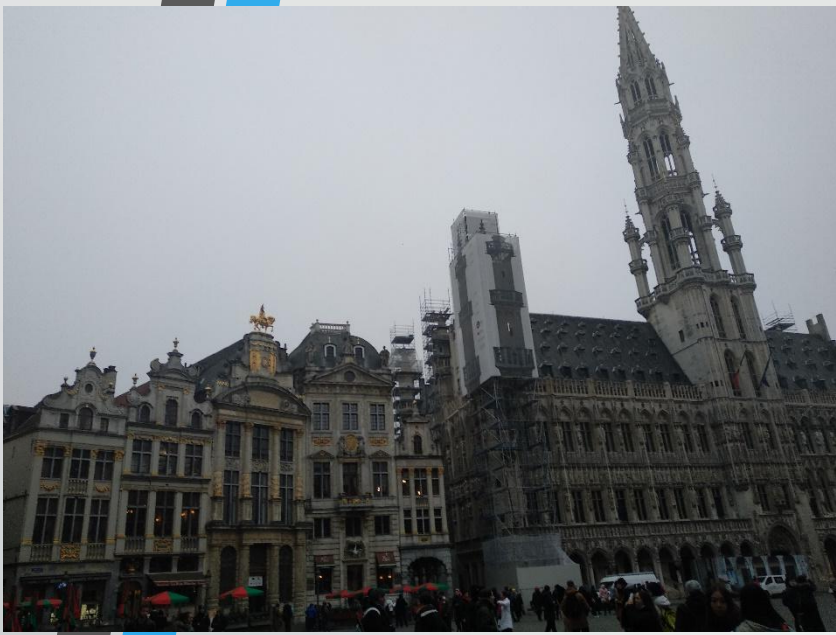

19/01/2020 - 24/01/2020

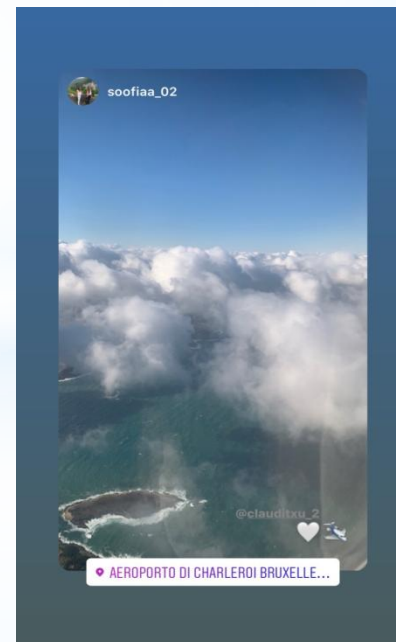

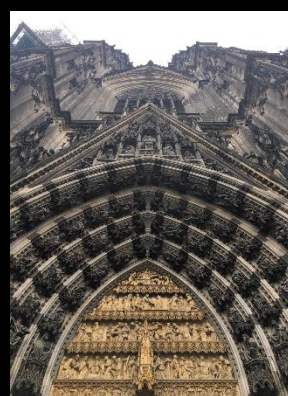

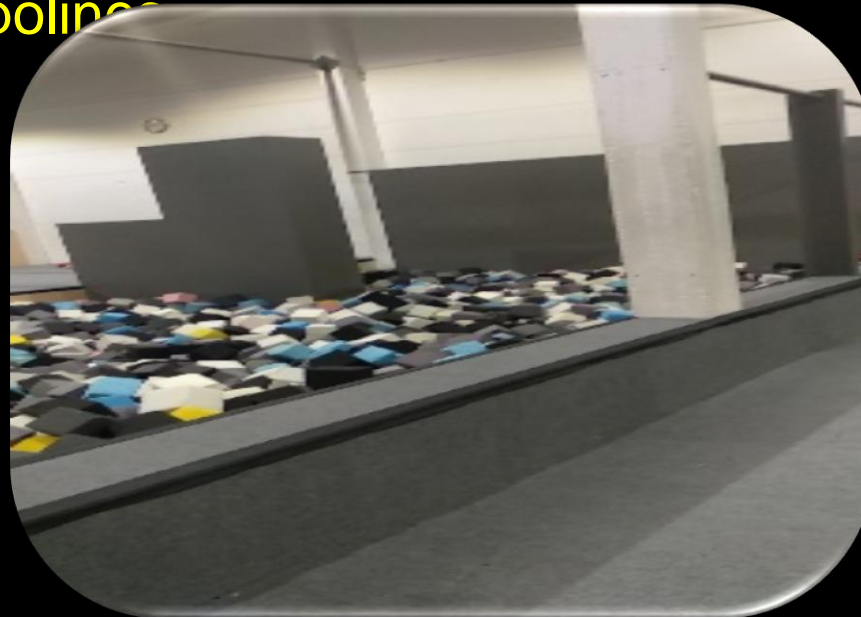
ARRIVAL (SUNDAY 19)

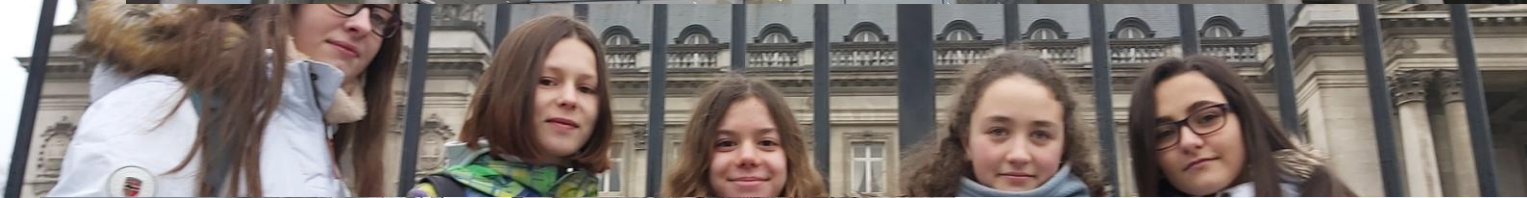
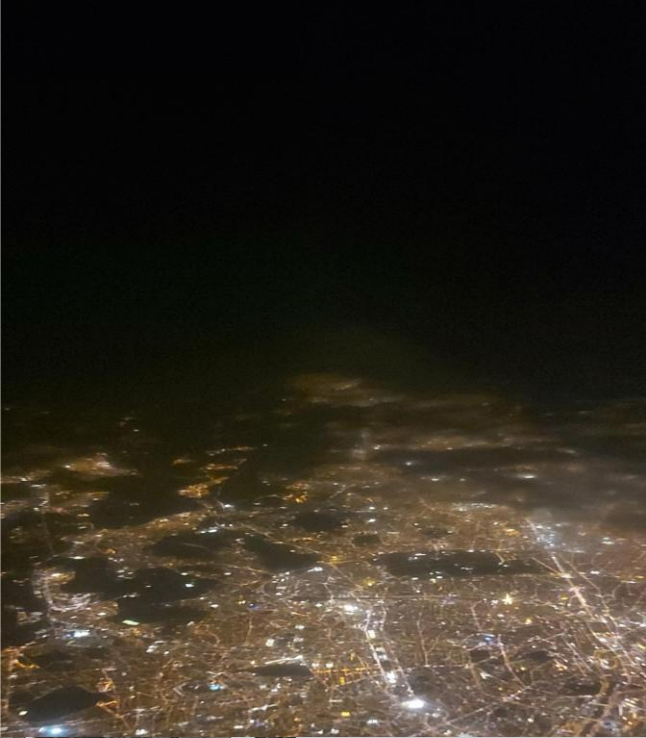
THURSDAY 23

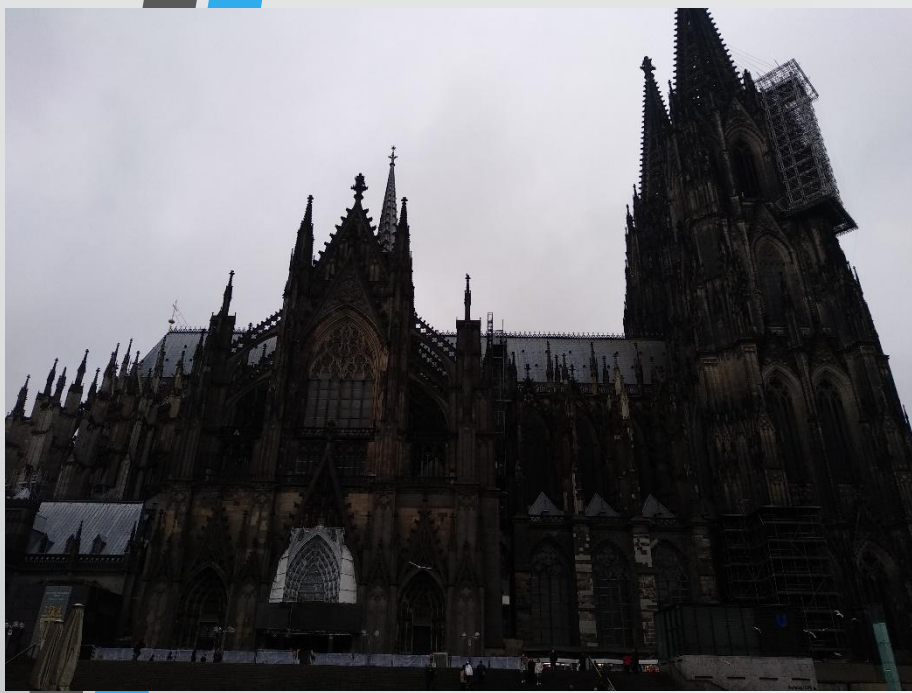
Second day

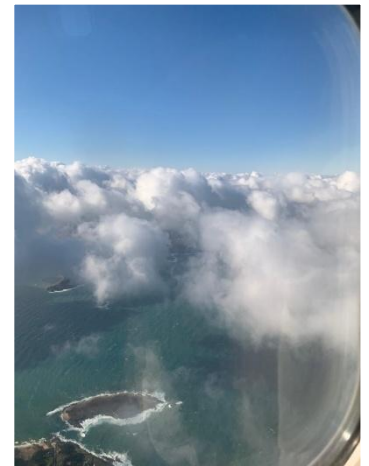
I woke up at nine am to take the bus that would take me to Santander.
