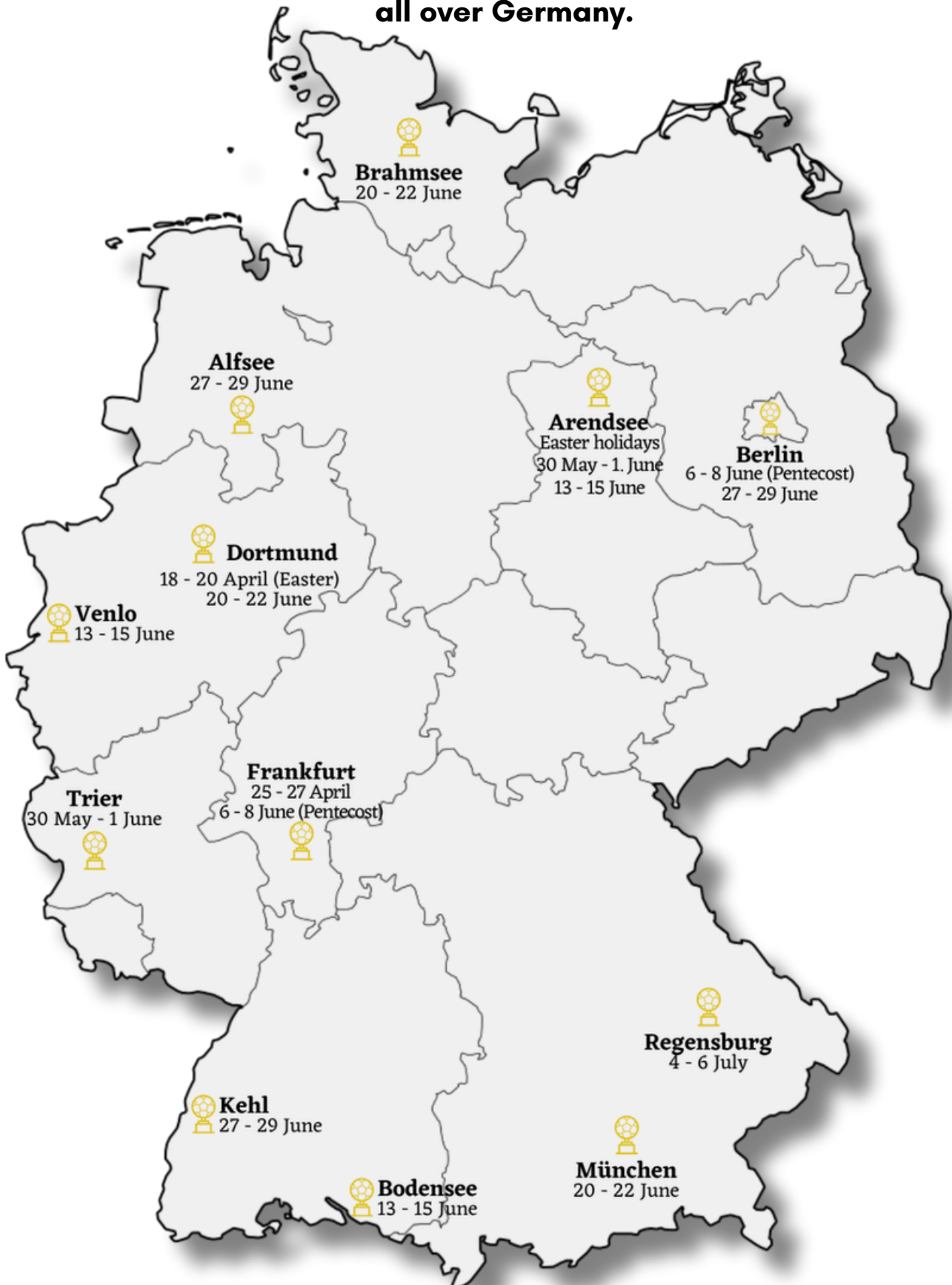

Tournament mode

- Two day tournament (Saturday/Sunday); Opening ceremony on Friday evening

- All placements are played
- Short breaks between the matches
- Each team the same number of matches
- Each team plays in the morning or in the afternoon
